Rules

1. **ENTRIES:** Mailed or faxed entries may be submitted beginning March 14, 2008. Please use the enclosed entry form. You may download this packet at www.unitedactionforyouth.org. All entries must be received by May 30, 2008.

Individuals or groups may enter in only one division but may enter multiple exhibit classes. Individuals or groups are allowed one free entry per class. A group is considered two or more individuals.
2. **FEES:** There are no registration fees unless you submit more than one entry per class. Fees for additional entries per class: Professional Division: \$5.00/entry. Amateur Division: \$1.00/entry. Youth Division: not applicable. If applicable, please pay fees when you drop off your entries on June 4th.
3. **ELIGIBILITY:** Determined by division.
 - *Professional:* Individuals who are or have been paid for floral or horticultural services.
 - *Amateur:* Individuals who are 18 years or older.
 - *Youth:* Individuals who are under 18 years of age.
4. **JUDGING:** Classes will be awarded 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place certificates by division. Certificates will be mailed to entrants if they are not in attendance during the evening event.
5. **PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARD:** This award will be given to an individual exhibitor or to a group exhibit's contact person. Attendees may cast their vote between Noon - 6:30 PM on June 5, 2008.
6. **BEST OF SHOW AWARD:** This award will be given to an individual exhibitor or to a group exhibit's contact person as determined by the judges.

The BEST OF SHOW and PEOPLE'S CHOICE awards will be announced just before the live auction on June 5, 2008.

7. **CERTIFICATE OF RECOGNITION:** All entrants will receive a printed certificate for participation in this event. Certificates will be mailed to individuals or to the group contact person.
8. **TITLE AND VALUE:** A title card must accompany each exhibit entry. Use black waterproof ink and legibly print or type the title and value of your entry on a 4" x 6" index card. Please indicate sun exposure conditions (full sun, partial sun, or shade) for all container gardens.
9. **INSTALLATION:** Entries must be dropped between 2:00 and 7:00 PM on June 4th at Brown Deer Golf Course. Volunteers will be on hand to check in and move entries into the facility.

10. **Plant List (Optional):** If you'd like to provide a plant list for the purchaser, please use the form provided on the website to type or print the information. Place the entry's title at the top and turn in with your entry. www.unitedactionforyouth.org

Class 1 Miniatures (7" and under) – Theme: It's a Small World After All

- Exhibit allotted 10" x 10" square design space.
- Floral design to consist predominately of fresh plant material.

Class 2 Floral arrangements – Theme: Magical Celebration

- Exhibit allotted 20" x 20" square design space.
- Floral design to consist predominately of fresh plant material.

Class 3 Container Garden – Theme: Enchanted Summer

- Exhibit allotted 36" x 36" square design space.
- Floral design to consist predominately of live plants.
- Container size:
 - Minimum size is 6" in diameter.
 - Maximum size is 16" in diameter.
- Container garden weigh less than 40 pounds
